Invoking the jurisdiction of this Tribunal under Section 14 of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007, the applicant has filed this OA and prays for the following reliefs:-

*“(a) To direct the Respondent to quash/set aside the Impugned Order(s) dated 02.01.2023, 03.07.2023 and 10.01.2024.*

*(b) To direct the respondents to grant Premature Separation from services (PSS) to the Applicant.*

*(c) to grant such other relief appropriate to the facts and circumstances of the case as deemed fit and proper.”*

2. While hearing the matter on 16.10.2024, we were informed that the case of the applicant for grant of discharge would be considered in the proceeding of the Board which was to be held in December, 2024 and today when the matter is

taken up, we have been informed that the case of the applicant was considered in the Board which met in December, 2024 and vide order passed on 26.12.2024 the applicant has been granted premature discharge. His name appears at Sl. No.13 of the communication produced before us bearing No.PO/331 dated 26.12.2024.

3. In view of the fact that the prayer made by the applicant has already been granted by the respondents, the matter has been rendered infructuous, it is disposed of accordingly.
