Invoking jurisdiction of this Tribunal under section 14 of the Armed Forces Tribunals Act, 2007, the applicant has filed this application. In para 8 of the Application the following reliefs are claimed:-


*“(a) Direct Respondents to grant disability element Pension @50% after rounding off from 40% for life as recommended by RMB to the applicant with effect from 01 Sep 2019 i.e. the date of discharge from service with interest @12% till final payment is made.”*

2. The respondents have filed a counter affidavit and much has been indicated by them in the counter affidavit that the claim of the applicant has been referred to the competent authority and it has been accepted and action is being taken to issue PPO. After filing of the counter affidavit on 02.09.2024, respondents have brought on

record PPO bearing No.243201902102 issued on 21.09.2024 indicating payment of benefits to the applicant.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid, we find that the benefit of disability rounded off to 50% has been granted to the applicant and, therefore, nothing further survives in the matter as disability pension has already been granted to the applicant. The Application is disposed of. In case the applicant has any grievance in the matter he may seek restoration of the Application.
