

The applicant has filed this application, i.e., MA 1058/2026, praying for grant of leave for impugning the order dated 22.01.2026 passed in RA 66/2023 in OA 223/2017 to the Hon'ble Supreme Court in terms of Section 30 and 31 of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007.

2. Having gone through the records, we find no point of law much less any point of law of general public importance involved in the matter. That apart, now in accordance to the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court, the applicant has a remedy of challenging the order before the Hon'ble High Court under Article 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India and, therefore, all the more, the application itself is not

maintainable. Hence the prayer for leave to appeal is declined.

3. Accordingly, the MA stands dismissed.
