This application has been filed for early hearing of OA 3400/2024.

2. In OA 3400/2024, the applicant prays for disability benefit for two ailments, i.e., (i) Bilateral High Frequency Sensorineural Hearing Loss (H-90.3) and (ii) Coronary Artery Disease – Microvascular Angina (I-25.1).

3. As far as, the ailment (i) is concerned, it is found to be aggravated on account of military service and ailment (ii) is held to be not attributable to nor aggravated by military service. In the counter affidavit also, the said position is established from the pleadings of the respondents.

4. In this application for early hearing, learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant gives up the

prayer for the second ailment of Coronary Artery Disease – Microvascular Angina (I-25.1) and only prays for grant of the disability benefit for the ailment of Bilateral High Frequency Sensorineural Hearing Loss (H-90.3) which is found to be aggravated by military service.

5. Taking note of the aforesaid, we have heard the OA 3400/2024 and reserved it for orders with regard to grant of the disability benefit for the ailment of Bilateral High Frequency Sensorineural Hearing Loss (H-90.3).

6. With the aforesaid, the MA stands disposed of.
