Seeking execution of an order passed by this Tribunal in OA No. 779/2025 on 20.03.2025, this application has been filed. The OA was filed by the applicant seeking grant of one notional increment in accordance to the law laid down in the case of Director (Admn. And HR) KFTCL and Others Vs. C.P. Muddinamani and Others [(2023) SCC Online SC 401] as also in SLP(C) No.4722 of 2021- Union of India & Anr. v. M. Siddaraj. The OA was disposed of on the very first day without notice to the respondents. However, respondents were given liberty to pass an appropriate order in case on verification they find that the applicant is not entitled to the benefit.

Today the respondents have brought on record a speaking order passed by the Competent Authority in the matter on

05.06.2025 wherein from Para 6 onwards it is indicated that after grant of last increment the applicant had not completed one year of service. He had only completed 09 months of service and for the reasons indicated in Para 5 of the order dated 05.06.2025, the benefit of notional increment has been denied to him. In view of the above, nothing further survives in this execution application. In case, the applicant is aggrieved by the order passed rejecting his claim, he may take such steps as are available to him for redressal of his grievance. With the aforesaid liberty to the applicant, the MA stands disposed of.
