Three months' time was granted for compliance and notice of this M.A. was also issued way back on 31.05.2012. In these circumstances, there is no justification for not complying with the order. So far as filing of the review is concerned, that does not, in any manner, come in the way of compliance of the order, as legally speaking even if the review is allowed and the order is set aside, Section 144 CPC is very much available to the respondents, to claim restitution. In that view of the matter, time is granted subject to payment of costs of Rs.10,000/- to the petitioner.
