MA 148/2023

Keeping in view the averments made in the miscellaneous application and finding the same to be bonafide, in the light of the decision in *Union of India and others Vs. Tarsem Singh* (2008) 8 sec 648, the same is allowed condoning the delay in filing the O.A.

OA 52/2023

In this OA, the only question that arises for consideration 2. is as to whether an employee who retired on 30th June of a year is entitled to be extended the benefit of increment that falls due on 1st July of that year. The applicant in this Army on 27.06.1991 enrolled Indian and on though service on **30.06.2021**. He was denied discharged from increment that fell due on 01.07.2022 on the ground that after the 7th Central Pay Commission, the Central Government fixed 1st

July/ 1st January as the date of increment for all Government employees and he was no more in service.

- 3. At the admission stage itself we are disposing off the case in view of the settled law position on grant of increments, as the issue involved in the matter stands concluded by the judgement rendered by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Civil Appeal 2471/2023*, *decided on 11.04.2023 in Director (Admn. And HR) KPTCL & Ors Vs CP Mundinamani & Ors*. We direct the respondents to decide the claim of the applicant for grant of increment for the period 1st July, 2020 to 30th June, 2021 and consequential dues flowing from the same. To be complied within a period of two months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
 - 4. The OA is **disposed off**. There shall be no order as to costs.
