Heard the learned counsel appearing for the applicant. The applicant is the widow of MWO Gopalakrishnan, who died on 28.2.1999, after completing 35 years and 149 days of service in the Indian Air Force. Now, the widow of late Gopalakrishnan has filed this application for issuing an attributability certificate to enable her son to get LPG distributorship. The second

respondent has rejected the same, which made the applicant to approach this Tribunal. When it was revealed to the counsel appearing for the applicant that this application is not maintainable before this Tribunal, since it will not come under Section 3(o) of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007, the learned counsel has come forward to withdraw the same. An endorsement is made on the application to that effect.

2. The application, O.A. No.113 of 2011 is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the applicant to approach the appropriate forum, on the same cause of action.
