Guidelines/Instructions For the Examination

- The question paper shall consist of 100 MCQs (Multiple Choice Questions) relating to (i) Criminal Law, (ii) Civil Law, (iii) Constitutional Law and (iv) General Aptitude (20 questions each) & Questions relating to (v) General knowledge and (vi) AFT Act, 2007 (10 questions each).
- 2. The examination will be of 60 minutes duration.
- 3. Based on the merit list, 50 candidates will be shortlisted for the Interview/Personality Test. The final selection shall be at the sole discretion of the Hon'ble Chairperson, Armed Forces Tribunal.
- 4. For every correct answer, 01 Mark shall be awarded and for every incorrect answer 0.25 Mark shall be deducted.
- 5. Candidates must report to the examination centre by 9.15 A.M i.e. 45 minutes before the commencement of the examination.
- 6. Mobile phones or any other electronic devices are strictly prohibited inside the examination centre. Candidates bringing such items shall be personally responsible in case of loss/theft.
- 7. If any candidate is found engaging in unfair means or misconduct shall be debarred from the examination.
- 8. Candidates must bring their original Aadhar Card as a valid identity proof.



- 9. Candidates are advised to regularly check the official website of AFT Delhi (aftdelhi.nic.in) for updates, if any.
- 10. Admit cards can be downloaded from the website of AFT five days prior to the examination date.
