OFFICE ORDER

The cases relating to COVID-19 have been reduced significantly in the NCT of Delhi. As directed by Hon'ble the Chairperson, from 02.03.2022 till further orders, there shall be complete resumption of physical hearings in this Tribunal. After complete resumption of physical hearing, the court may, in exceptional circumstances on case to case basis, permit hybrid/video conferencing hearing. However, due to non-availability of Members (Administrative) in the Principal Bench, the Courts no. 1 and 3 shall sit on alternate days and the Court no. 2 shall continue through video conferencing as per existing arrangement.

The Advocates, staff officials, litigants and other visitors to the Courts shall follow all the COVID-19 protocols, guidelines, directions, etc. issued by the Government of India, Government of NCT of Delhi and by this office from time to time.
